

- ✓ Full vaccination history – Flu and EHV1-4
- ✓ Analysis results
- ✓ Signed contract & Filled up mare form

VACCINATION



In case of a break in the vaccination protocol: restart a primary vaccination course with 2 injections given 21 to 60 days apart

CEM (Contagious Equine Metritis)

EVA (Equine Viral Arteritis)

Negative result test dated less than 30 days before each cover. ELISA or serum neutralization.
If positive: two stable or declining serological results taken 14 days apart.

Coggins test

Not mandatory, but recommended. To be carried out after January 1st, 2026.

HIGH RISK MARES

- mares who have had previous contact with CEMO
- mares covered by infected stallion
- mares who originate from countries other than France, Germany, England, Ireland, Italy, USA, Canada

► Two negative clitoral swabs taken 7 days apart
► One negative cervical swab taken after January 1st, 2026

CHANGE OF STALLION

In the event of a change of stallion during the breeding season, new tests for Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA) and Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM) must be carried out on samples taken no earlier than 7 days after the last covering (CEM) and 14 days after the last covering (EVA).

*An identification check will be carried out using the microchip number and the original passport.
Sumbe reserves the right to request any additional tests it deems necessary.*

In the event of an incomplete or non-compliant file, Sumbe may refuse to cover the mare.

Please note that foal heat coverings are not a priority, and Sumbe reserves the right to accept or refuse them.
